BELLBROOK BEAUTIFICATION AWARD PROGRAM

- The Bellbrook Beautification Committee consists of three to seven members.
- The Committee members select homes they deem to be well maintained and aesthetically pleasing to the community.
- Homes need a visible house number.
- The city is divided into five sections.
- Each Committee member chooses four homes from their assigned section and a business.
- The selections are then compiled and voted on by the entire committee picking two of the four homes in each section, and their choice for business.

RULES FOR HOME OWNERS

- Homes must be within the City of Bellbrook Corporation limits.
- Homes must be approved by a majority of the committee.
- Homes must be in good repair, aesthetically pleasing, and have a visible house number.
- Prior to public announcement the committee chair must make homeowners aware of the award.
- Homeowners must be willing to have their homes photographed.

- Photographs of their homes may be displayed in a public place.
- Winners will have a temporary sign placed on their lawn for approximately one month.
- Two winners will be chosen from each section, with the exception of a tie.
- All winners will be recognized at a council meeting.
- A winning home is ineligible to win again for a period of five years.
- All rules are the same for businesses, but only one business will be chosen.
