March 24, 2019 – 1427 hours

An officer assisted the Greene County Sheriff's Department with an attempt to serve a resident on Bellemeade Drive a warrant. A relative advised the wanted person no longer lives at the residence.

An officer stopped a vehicle on Wilmington-Dayton Road after a routine registration check revealed that the driver did not have a valid driver's license. While speaking with the 25-year old male driver from Bellbrook the officer could smell a strong odor of marijuana omitting from the vehicle. Drug paraphernalia was found and seized in addition to marijuana. The suspect was cited into Xenia Municipal Court for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. A warning was issued for Expired Driver's License.
