October 20, 2019 – 0107 hours

Officers were dispatched to the West Franklin area for a possible impaired driver traveling thru the City of Bellbrook. An officer observed the vehicle in question enter the city limits and conducted a traffic stop based on a moving violation in the city. Investigation led to the arrest of the driver for OVI.

October 21, 2019 – 1106 hours

A citizen of Bellbrook came to the Bellbrook Police station to report that he was a recent victim of a phone / computer virus scam. Investigation revealed that the citizen had been “scammed” out of a large amount of money. The citizen’s bank was notified.
