April 24, 2022 – 0213 hours

While on patrol, officers located an open garage door on Beechwood Drive. Officers made contact with the resident and the door was secured.

April 24, 2022 – 0926 hours

Officers were dispatched to Hess Road for a damage to vehicle complaint. Sometime earlier, a vehicle had hit a parked car and caused damage. Officers were able to identify the driver and vehicle by viewing video surveillance. The driver was located and cited for Failure to Control.

April 24, 2022 – 1114 hours

A possible domestic disturbance was reported on Bellemeade Drive. One party had left prior to officers' arrival. It was determined that the disturbance was verbal only and no threats had been made.

April 24, 2022 – 1344 hours

A damaging complaint was reported on Caudell Drive. Unknown subjects damaged a mailbox sometime overnight. No suspects at this time.

April 24, 2022 – 1519 hours

A damaging complaint was reported on S. East Street. Unknown subjects damaged the homeowners fence. No suspects at this time.

April 25, 2022 – 1138 hours

A parking complaint was reported on Dane Lane. Officers located the owner of the vehicle, who agreed to move the car.

April 26, 2022 – 0147 hours

While on patrol, officers located an open door at a business on N. Main Street. The business checked OK and officers attempted to contact a keyholder to resecure the door.



April 27, 2022 – 2149 hours

A disabled vehicle was reported on W. Franklin Street near S. Linda Drive. Officers assisted with traffic control until the vehicle was removed.

April 27, 2022 – 2228 hours

A suspicious person was reported to be seen walking around a house on Polo Trace Court. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the subject. The perimeter of the house checked secure and officers made contact with the resident.

April 27, 2022 – 2242 hours

Officers were dispatched to Post regarding a domestic dispute, past occurred. Officers relocated to Kensington Drive to continue the investigation. Officers determined the dispute was physical and one individual was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail.

April 27, 2022 – 2317 hours

Bellbrook Officers assisted Kettering PD in locating an OVI suspect on Pinegrove Drive. Contact was made and KPD served the individual their citation.

April 28, 2022 – 0819 hours

Officers were dispatched to Nedra Drive on a residential alarm. Confirmed FA.

April 28, 2022 – 1230 hours

Officers responded to Kensington Drive to assist with a vehicle lockout. Entry gained.

April 28, 2022 – 1630 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on E. Franklin Street. Entry gained.



April 28, 2022 – 1719 hours

Officers responded to a business parking lot on State Route 725 on the report of an unresponsive subject. The individual was pronounced deceased on arrival. The investigation is ongoing and no foul play is suspected at this time.

April 29, 2022 – 0202 hours

While on patrol, officers located an open garage door on Kensington Drive. Officers made contact with the resident and the door was closed.

April 29, 2022 – 0208 hours

While on patrol, officers located an open garage door on Locus Bend Dr. Officers made contact with the resident and the door was closed.

April 29, 2022 – 2127 hours

Officers responded with the Medics to an unresponsive subject on S. Linda Drive. One individual was taken to the hospital for further treatment.

April 30, 2022 – 2323 hours

Officers were dispatched to a traffic crash on N. West Street, and it was reported that the at-fault party left the scene. Officers were able to locate the subject and initiated a traffic stop. Further investigation revealed that the two parties knew each other, and that the accident may have been intentional. Based on statements, it was also determined that an assault had occurred prior to the crash. One individual was taken into custody and transported to the Greene County Jail.
