July 10, 2022 – 1349 hours

Officers responded to Upper Hillside Drive on a family dispute. Officers were able to separate the parties and come to an agreement. The Complainant was given information on the proper agencies to contact regarding Civil Matters.

July 10, 2022 – 1557 hours

Officers were dispatched to a traffic accident on W. Franklin Street. Further investigation revealed that the at-fault driver was also intoxicated. The driver was cited for ACDA and OVI. No injuries were reported.

July 10, 2022 – 1630 hours

Officers responded to Shadowleaf Drive on the report of a possible dispute. The investigation is ongoing.

July 11, 2022 – 0135 hours

While on patrol, officers noticed an open garage door on N. Belleview Dr. The resident was contacted and closed the door.

July 11, 2022 – 1414 hours

A resident on Lakeview Drive reported a theft, past occurred. Unknown subjects entered the shed in the backyard and stole several small tools and gasoline from the lawnmower.

July 10, 2022 – 1557 hours

While on patrol, officers located an open door at a business on State Route 725. The building was checked and the door was secured.

July 13, 2022 – 1642 hours

A reckless driver was reported on N. Main Street. The caller stated that the driver was swerving and crossing over marked lanes. Officers were able to stop the vehicle near Ridgeway Road. After speaking with the driver, they determined there was no cause for complaint.



July 14, 2022 – 1824 hours

A disabled vehicle was reported on W. Franklin Street. The vehicle was GOA.

July 15, 2022 – 0158 hours

Officers conducted a traffic stop on Wilmington-Dayton Road for no visible registration. Officers detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and an open container of alcohol inside the vehicle. The driver passed all field sobriety tests and did not show signs of impairment and was issued citations for the open container and improper display of registration.

July 15, 2022 – 0932 hours

Officers were dispatched to Hillrise Circle on an unwanted subject refusing to leave the property. Officers located the subject and trespassed them from the property at the request of the homeowner. Officers transported the subject to Post without incident.

July 15, 2022 – 2214 hours

Telephone harassment was reported on South Linda Drive. Officers advised both parties to cease communication with each other.

July 16, 2022 – 1835 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lock-out on Washington Mill Rd. Entry gained.

July 16, 2022 – 1951 hours

A welfare check was requested on a driver reported to be slumped over the wheel of a car in a parking lot on State Route 725. Officers were able to locate the vehicle on Bellemead Drive. The driver explained he closed his eyes for a moment as he waited for his passenger to return from a restaurant. Neither occupant showed any signs of impairment, and everyone checked OK. No cause for complaint.
