October 2, 2022 – 0225 hours

Officers conducted a traffic stop on Wilmington-Dayton Road after observing the driver traveling left of center. Further investigation resulted in the driver being cited for multiple violations, including OVI, left of center and open container in a motor vehicle.

October 2, 2022 – 0228 hours

Officers were dispatched to Woodacre Drive on a 9-1-1 open line. Officers spoke with both residents and determined there was no cause for complaint.

October 2, 2022 – 1449 hours

Officers responded to N. Main Street for a single vehicle accident. No injuries were reported and one individual was cited for Failure to Control.

October 4, 2022 – 1723 hours

Officers were dispatched to Clearview Drive on a possible dispute. Officers determined there was insufficient evidence for charges and the parties agreed to separate.

October 6, 2022 – 1542 hours

Officers were dispatched to Lakeview Drive on an individual with a warrant out of GCSO. Officers were able to take custody of the subject until GCSO Deputies arrived.

October 6, 2022 – 1850 hours

A welfare check was requested for a pedestrian on Belleview Drive. The subject checked ok but needed help getting back home. Officers were able to safely transport the individual back to their residence.

October 6, 2022 – 1924 hours

Officers responded to Lakeview Drive on a barking dog complaint. Officers were able to locate the owner and issued a verbal warning for barking dog.



October 7, 2022 – 2115 hours

Officers were dispatched to Wead Place on a loud music complaint. Officers located the source of the music, and the resident stated the band was only playing for a bit longer. Officers stayed in the area to ensure the band stopped playing when they were supposed to.

Officers were dispatched to Sugar Run Trail on a residential alarm. Confirmed FA.

October 8, 2022 – 1216 hours

Officers spoke with a resident on Bledsoe Drive regarding a theft complaint. Subjects from Facebook Marketplace used counterfeit money to purchase an item. The investigation is ongoing.

Officers were dispatched to Woodedge Drive on a barking dog complaint. The owner brought the dog inside without incident.
