November 13, 2022 – 1812 hours

Officers were dispatched to Marcia Drive on a barking dog complaint. One individual was given a verbal warning for barking dog.

November 13, 2022 – 2302 hours

Officers responded to Ivy Crest Drive on a residential alarm. Confirmed FA.

November 13, 2022 – 2320 hours

Officers initiated a traffic stop on Vemco Drive after witnessing a vehicle drive off the road. Further investigation led to the driver being cited for OVI.

November 15, 2022 – 1313 hours

Officers responded to Post to meet with a complainant regarding a forgery complaint involving an altered check. The investigation has been forwarded to the Detective section and is ongoing.

November 16, 2022 – 1917 hours

Officers responded to Poston Drive on the report of an unwanted person refusing to leave the property. The parties were separated upon arrival, and one person was issued a verbal trespass warning at the request of the homeowner. The subject left without incident.

November 17, 2022 – 0937 hours

A welfare check was requested on Callaway Court. The resident checked OK.

November 18, 2022 – 0033 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 on the report of an individual who continued to enter the business with an open container of alcoholic beverage and harass the worker. Officers located the individual sitting outside the business. Further investigation led to the individual being charged with Disorderly Conduct – Public Intoxication and Open Container. The subject was transported to the Greene County Jail.



November 18, 2022 – 1328 hours

A welfare check was requested for an individual on Upper Bellbrook Road. Officers were unable to locate the individual but learned that they may be traveling to Xenia. Officers notified Xenia PD, who were able to make contact with the subject.

November 18, 2022 – 2328 hours

A Peace Officer was requested on Nedra Drive to standby for a property exchange.

November 19, 2022 – 1534 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on W. Franklin Street. Entry gained.

November 19, 2022 – 1854 hours

Officers responded to Maxwell Drive after a resident reported that they saw a flashlight in their backyard. Officers searched the yard and the area but were unable to locate anyone, and there were no signs of criminal activity.

November 19, 2022 – 2238 hours

While on patrol, officers located a suspicious person walking beside a vehicle in the roadway on Kensington Drive. Officers stopped to speak to the individual, who stated he had been assaulted by a known individual on Weller Drive. Further investigation led to one individual being charged with assault and issued a court summons.
