November 27, 2022 - 1004 hours

Officers were dispatched to State Route 725 on the report of a theft and breaking & entering. Unknown suspects broke the front window of two separate businesses sometime overnight and stole cash and items from both of the locations. The investigation is ongoing.

November 27, 2022 – 1409 hours
