A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL GRANT THROUGH THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG).

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook has adopted its Comprehensive Plan which outlines the importance of a walkable downtown area and promotes pedestrian access and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook held a Walkable Community Workshop in 2017 and indicated specifically that the area of North West Street that connects at Franklin Street currently has no sidewalks which allow safe access to the businesses located at Bellbrook Plaza; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook contracted LJB, Inc. to provide the necessary construction estimates of the project which has a total construction cost of \$80,944; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook would like to commit a match of 56% toward the final project costs that equates to no more than \$45,767, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook wishes to submit the North West/Franklin Street Pedestrian Access and Safety Project to Greene County for the Community Development Block Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLBROOK HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit an application to Greene County for the North West/Franklin Street Pedestrian Access and Safety Project as detailed above.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption.
