Officers were dispatched to Hess Rd. on a possible domestic dispute. After speaking to both parties involved, it was determined that the dispute was physical and one subject was placed under arrest.

May 19, 2024 – 1433 hours

May 21, 2024 – 0109 hours

While on patrol, officers noticed a suspicious vehicle at a business on Washington Mill Rd. Officers verified that the subject was an employee and permitted to be there.
