November 24, 2024 – 0255 hours

While on patrol, officers located a vehicle that was wanted in connection to felony charges from multiple jurisdictions. Officers attempted to initiate a traffic stop on Washington Mill Road, but the suspect and vehicle fled the scene. The suspect was later apprehended and taken into custody by other agencies. The investigation is ongoing.

November 24, 2024 - 1131 hours

Officers were dispatched to W. Maple Street for a domestic dispute. After speaking to the parties involved, it was determined the dispute was verbal only. Officers stood by as the parties agreed to separate for the day.

November 24, 2024 – 1455 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on E. Franklin Street. Entry gained.

November 24, 2024 – 1814 hours

Officers responded to State Route 725 for a business alarm. Confirmed FA.

November 25, 2024 – 1818 hours

Officers were dispatched to Tampico Trail on a child custody dispute. Officers determined the complaint was Civil and directed the parties to the proper authorities.

November 25, 2024 – 2144 hours

A welfare check was requested on Knob Hill Dr. While knocking on the door, officers could hear someone calling for help from inside. Officers were able to make entry and located the resident with injuries from a fall. Medics transported the resident to MVS for treatment.

A suspicious person was reported on Lakeview Drive. Officers were able to locate the subject and assist them in getting home.
